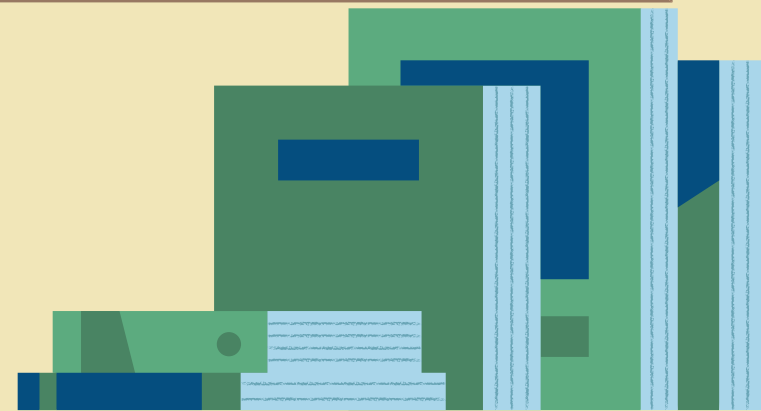


**MET ELEMENTARY
SUPPLY SUPPLY LIST
2023-2024**



1st & 2nd Grade School Supplies (2023-2024)

ALL students must bring all required supplies and all supplies should be divided into separate bags per subject area and clearly labeled with the subject, student's name, and class. Please note, We will not accept any supplies if they are delivered to school combined together in one large bag. Supplies should be separated by subject as outlined below.

For 1st & 2nd-grade Homeroom classes, each student will have his/her own individual supplies, which they can bring in a school supply box & stored in the student's desk or as assigned by the teacher.

We encourage all students to bring their supplies during the orientation day.

General supplies:

- Pencil case large enough to include:
 - Sharpened Pencils (minimum of 15)
 - 4 Erasers
 - 2 Pencil sharpener
 - 2 large glue sticks
 - 1 Package of crayons
 - Small scissors
- Whiteboard markers (2 Boxes)
- Colored pencils – 24 colors
- Small whiteboard
- 4 A4 spiral notebook (2 ELA-1MAth -1Genius Hour)
- 1 Box of paperclips (Grade 2 Only)
- 1 packet of sheet protectors (Grade 1 Only)
- White zipper folder
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer/Alcohol
- 2 Box of tissues
- 2 Box of wet wipes
- 2 Box of pencils to be in class
- 1 Ream of A4 papers
- **NO Permanent makers are allowed.**

3rd, 4th and 5th Grade School Supplies (2023-2024)

ALL students must bring all required supplies and all supplies should be divided into separate bags per subject area and clearly labeled with the subject, student's name, and class. To ensure that all students have the correct and proper supplies they need to accompany their learning each day, Grade 3-5 students are asked to have the mentioned general supplies on the list in their pencil cases/backpacks every day they come to school for the entire year starting from the first day of school.
